

Borrowing eBooks using the student portal

Wheelers eBooks -

The School Library has a subscription and there is 1000+ eBooks available.

Follow these instructions and screenshots below to learn how you can borrow eBooks.

1. Logon to the student portal and click on either OLIVER Library or My School Library (Oliver).
2. Use the catalogue search screen to type in the author, title or series that you want to borrow.
3. If you get a match look for the iPad icon to indicate the book is available as an eBook then click on it.
4. Click on Borrow eBook.
5. The eBook will load and you can start reading!
6. The eBook will automatically keep your place so you can go back to it at any time.
7. The loan is for two weeks and will automatically drop off after that.
8. You can have two eBooks on loan at one time. You can also reserve titles that are not available.
