Updated Information

Below is the information pertinent to parents/carers and students that we received from Mark Scott (Secretary NSW Department of Education) and Murat Dizdar (Deputy Secretary, School Operations and Performance at the Department of Education) during the livestream on Thursday 2 April, 2020.

1. It is anticipated that all of Term 2 will reflect the past two weeks. i.e. schools will remain operational and that we will continue with the current flexible working arrangements.
