

Dear Parents / Carers, Students and Staff,

The wellbeing and safety of our students and staff continues to be paramount at Moorebank High School.

As a follow up from my email yesterday I need to reinforce the following new guidelines that take effect as of today.

- Vigilance in ensuring that staff and students do not attend school or work if they are unwell
- Students absent or sent home due to flu like symptoms need to be tested.
- Staff and students must not return to school or work until they return a negative COVID-19 result and are symptoms free
- Schools must sight the negative COVID-19 test result prior to allowing students and staff to return to school

“If a student develops flu like symptoms while at schools they should be sent home and not return to school until they have received a negative COVID-19 test result which is received and sighted by the school. Students should be marked as ‘Sick’ during this period.”

A copy of the negative student results need to be presented to the front office to Janet Lockwood, Jan Simpson or Cheryl Johnson.

A copy of the negative staff results need to be presented to the Principal.

Should your child be absent from school; the new message will read:

“MHS: {student_first_name} was marked absent from school {absence}. Anyone who is unwell with flu-like symptoms should arrange to be tested and notify the school immediately. Please reply to this SMS or call 9601 3999”
