Support Classes – Autism

Proposal and Consultation

Dear Parents / Carers and Students,

The Department of Education has approached Moorebank High School with the proposal of establishing Support Classes – for students with Autism within the school.

It has been identified that there is an unmet need in the Chipping Norton Network for students requiring a specialised support class. The proposal is for the establishment of a three support classes for students with Autism. This is a high demand in our area and the school is committed to meeting the needs of all of our students.

The classes will be located in existing classrooms within the school. These classes will have teaching and SLSO support and will have a maximum of seven students per class. It proposed to establish these support classes for the 2021 school year.

These students are not included in our cap numbers and will not impact local enrolments.
