HSC course exam rules and instructions

These rules and instructions must be followed to ensure fair and efficient assessment as per NESA and school HSC assessment policies.

Accessing examinations:

There will be NO face to face examinations - all examinations will take place online.

Specific instructions for each subject will be added to your google classroom. Ensure you have checked all your google classrooms for details on the format and submission method for each examination as they vary between subjects. Your submission for each exam must be uploaded as instructed by the end of each exam window.

Preparing for your exams

When preparing for your exams, read the google classroom posts carefully to ensure you are familiar with the format and distribution arrangements of the examination, including how to submit your answers. For each course you are studying, know the rules and requirements, and what to expect in each exam.

Read your examination timetable carefully and ensure that you are prepared and logged in at least 15 minutes prior to the indicated start time.

The duration and/or structure of most examinations has changed since the previous version of the timetable. Ensure you check the times in this document against the posts made in your google classroom.

Exam equipment

Refer to your google classroom for advice specific to your subjects. Ensure you have sufficient supplies of everything identified. Prepare a glass of water, box of tissues and anything else you might need during the course of the examination. Set yourself up in a distraction free environment that is conducive to completing an assessment task.

Ensure all equipment you require, such as a calculator, is in good working order.

Ensure that the device you are using has sufficient charge and/or is plugged in for the duration of the examination. All examinations will be considered 'open book' tasks, so you may wish to arrange any study notes or other resources in a logical manner prior to commencement.

Questions or Issues

Questions or issues regarding the examination timetable and/or arising from these rules and instructions must be directed to Dr Griffin or Mrs Richards.

Questions or issues regarding the nature of each exam or submission methods must be directed to your class teacher.

In the event of technical difficulties during the task, you must call the school on 9601 3999 or 96013766 and describe the nature of your issue.

Illness/Misadventure

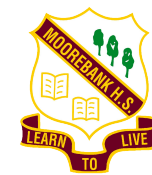
You must sit for all your exams at the scheduled time and make all submissions within the exam window. If you miss an examination, you or your parent must ring the school on the day of the exam on ph. 9601 3999 or 96013766 and leave a message with the office staff to explain the circumstances. You will be asked for your name, the exam you have missed or had problems with, the general nature of the issue (illness, technical problems, etc.)

You may then be asked to complete an Illness/ Misadventure Form. If you miss an examination, you will be required to complete a supplementary examination.

Failure to contact the school on or before the day of the missed examination is very likely to result in a mark of zero for that exam.

An Illness/Misadventure claim must include clear and specific documented evidence for consideration by the Senior Assessment Committee and Deputy Principal. Screenshots to support claims of technical issues are advised. Illness/Misadventure claims must be lodged to Dr Griffin or Mrs Richards later on the day of the missed examination, or as soon as possible thereafter.

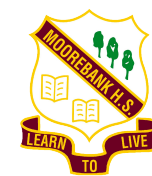
